#### **FINAL DECISION AND ORDER**

### **ISSUES:**

- 1. Did the Board fail to promptly identify the Student as a Student with a Disability under the IDEA?
- 2. Did the Board fail to provide FAPE?
- 3. Was the behavior, which was the subject of discipline a manifestation of the Student's disability?
- 4. If the Board failed to provide Student with FAPE, do the circumstances warrant an award of compensatory education?

#### PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:

The Parent filed the Expedited Due Process Complaint and Request for Hearing on October 27, 2017. The Hearing Officer was appointed on October 30, 2017 and conducted a Prehearing Conference on November 7, 2017. The hearing was scheduled for November 27, 2017. On November 16, 2017, the Parents' attorney withdrew the Due Process Complaint with prejudice.

## **FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:**

The matter is **DISMISSED** with prejudice.
