FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

1. Did the Board provide an appropriate program for the 2018-2019 school year?
2. Does the alleged bullying impede the Student's ability to obtain meaningful benefit from the IEP?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:

The Parent filed the Due Process Complaint and Request for Hearing on July 13, 2018. The Hearing Officer was appointed on July 18, 2018 and issued a notice of a Prehearing Conference on July 26, 2018. On July 24, 2018, the Parent notified the Hearing Officer that the parties had come to an agreement as a result of a Resolution Session and that the Parent was withdrawing the Due Process Complaint with prejudice.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is **DISMISSED** with prejudice.
