FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

- 1. Did the Westport Board of Education fail to provide Student with a Free and Appropriate Public Education for the 2018-19 school year?
- 2. Should the Board be required to reimburse Parents for their unilateral placement of Student at Riverview School?
- 3. Should the Board be required to provide compensatory services to the Student for the 2018-19 school year?

PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND:

Counsel for the Student filed this Request for Due Process Hearing on July 27, 2018. The Hearing Officer was assigned on July 30, 2018. A Prehearing Conference was scheduled, and held on August 15, 2018, at which hearing dates were set. Counsel reported that mediation had been scheduled for this matter. A hearing was set for September 17, 2018. On September 13, 2018 the parties informed the Hearing Officer that they had reached an agreement as a result of that mediation and requested the matter be dismissed.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The case is DISMISSED without prejudice.
