- 1. Did the Board offer an appropriate program for the 2016-2017, 2017-2018, 2018-2019, including the 2017 and 2018 extended school years?
- 2. If not, is placement at Flex School the appropriate program for the Student for the 2018-2019 school year and should the Board be ordered to place the Student Flex School for the 2018-2018 school year and reimburse the Parents for any tuition expended?
- 3. Is the Student entitled to compensatory education?
