ISSUES:

1. Are the Board Evaluations appropriate?
2. If not, are the Parents entitled to an independent occupational therapy evaluation at public expense?
3. If not, are the Parents entitled to an independent speech and language evaluation at public expense?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:

The Board filed the Due Process Complaint and Request for Hearing on February 26, 2019. The Hearing Officer was appointed on March 1, 2019. A Prehearing Conference was held on March 13, 2019. The parties had hearing dates scheduled for May 2 and May 13, 2019. The mailing date was April 15, 2019. On April 11, 2019, the Board requested an extension of the mailing date and were granted a one-month extension until May 15, 2019. On April 26, 2019, the parties attended a resolution session and the parents withdrew their request for an IEE, and the Board indicated that they were withdrawing their Due Process Request for hearing.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is **DISMISSED**.
