FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

1. Did the District provide the Student with FAPE for the 2016-2017, 2017-2018 and 2018-2019 school years including extended school years services for 2017 and 2018?
2. If not, is placement at Options an appropriate placement for the Student for the 2018-2019 school year and is the District responsible for placing the Student at Options?
3. Is the Student entitled compensatory education and/or to any other relief as deemed appropriate by the Hearing Officer?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:

The Parent filed the Due Process Complaint and Request for Hearing on March 18, 2019. The Hearing Officer was appointed on March 18, 2019. A Prehearing Conference took place on March 25th. It was indicated that the parties were hoping to settle the case. The Hearing Officer received notice by email from counsel for the Parent on June 2nd, withdrawing the Parent's due process request.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is **DISMISSED** with prejudice.
