## **FINAL DECISION AND ORDER**

#### **ISSUES:**

- 1. Did the Board provide the Student FAPE for the 2018-2019 School Year, including ESY 2019?
- 2. Did the Board offer the Student FAPE for the 2019-2020 School Year?
- 3. Does the Hearing Officer have jurisdiction over the Student's claim under 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973?
- 4. If so, did the Board provide the Student FAPE under 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 for the 2018-2019 School Year, including ESY 2019?
- 5. If so, did the Board provide the Student FAPE under 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 for the 2019-2020 School Year?

## PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:

Parents filed their Due Process Complaint and Request for Hearing on July 8, 2019. The Hearing Officer was appointed on July 11, 2019. The Prehearing Conference was held on July 22, 2019 and the Parties advised they would participate in mediation. The Parties reported a settlement in principle on September 9, 2019 and requested an extension of the mailing date to finalize their settlement agreement. The mailing date was extended to October 14, 2019 for this purpose. On October 2, 2019, via email, the Parents withdrew their Complaint due to a final settlement.

### FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

In light of the above, the matter is **DISMISSED**.
