## **FINAL DECISION AND ORDER**

### **ISSUES:**

- 1. Was an appropriate program offered to the Student by the Board for the 2018-2019 and 2019-2020 school years, including ESY for 2019?
- 2. If the Student was denied FAPE for during this time, is placement at The Southport School appropriate for the Student?
- 3. Are the Parents entitled to reimbursement of the October 30<sup>th</sup>, 2017 Psychological Evaluation by Dr. Sutera?
- 4. Is the Student entitled to compensatory education and/or to any other relief as deemed appropriate by the Hearing Officer?

#### PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:

The Parents filed the Due Process Complaint and Request for Hearing on August 14, 2019. The Hearing Officer was appointed on August 15, 2019. A Prehearing Conference was held on September 9, 2019. On October 25<sup>th</sup>, the Hearing Officer was notified by the Parents' Counsel that the due process complaint was being withdrawn.

## **FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:**

The matter is **DISMISSED** with prejudice.
