FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

- 1. Did the Board offer an appropriate program for the 2019-2020 school year?
- 2. If not, is placement at Ben Bronz Academy the appropriate placement for the Student for the 2019-2020 school year, and should the Board be ordered to place the Student at Ben Bronz Academy for the 2019-2020 school year?
- 3. Is the Student entitled to compensatory education and/or any other relief deemed appropriate by the Hearing Officer?
