FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUE:

Did the Board improperly determine the Student to be ineligible for special education services?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:

The Student is entitled to receive a free and appropriate public education in the least restrictive environment as defined in the Individuals with Disabilities Education Improvement Act (“IDEA”) §20 U. S. C. 1401 et seq. and Connecticut General Statutes §10-76a et seq. The Board filed the Due Process Hearing Complaint on November 25, 2020. The Hearing Officer was appointed on November 26, 2020. A Pre-Hearing conference was held on December 19, 2019. Upon Motion by the parties, the date for mailing the final memorandum of decision was extended to March 19, 2020. A Hearing was scheduled for March 4, 2020. The Parent withdrew the complaint with prejudice on February 28, 2020.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is DISMISSED with prejudice.
