FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

- 1. Was the District's psychological evaluation appropriate?
- 2. If not, are the Parents entitled to a psychological independent educational evaluation at the expense of the District?
- 3. Was the District's achievement evaluation appropriate?
- 4. If not, are the Parents entitled to an achievement independent educational evaluation at the expense of the District?
- 5. Was the District's social work evaluation appropriate?
- 6. If not, are the Parents entitled to a social work independent educational evaluation at the expense of the District?

SUMMARY AND PROCEDURAL HISTORY:

Case 20-0268 was commenced by the Board on December 23, 2019. A prehearing conference was noticed but not held. The decision date is determined to be February 6, 2020.

On January 13, 2020, the undersigned hearing officer was advised by the Parents that they were withdrawing their request for an independent educational evaluation. On January 14, 2020, the undersigned hearing officer was advised by the attorney for the Board that the matter was being withdrawn without prejudice.
