FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

On January 2, 2020, the Bridgeport Board of Education ("BOE") filed a Request for Impartial Due Process Hearing.² The deadline to mail the final decision and order is February 16. The following issues are identified:

- 1. Is the Board of Education's educational evaluation of Student appropriate?
- 2. If the answer to Issue 1 is in the negative, is Student entitled to an independent evaluation at public expense?

A telephonic pre-hearing conference was scheduled for January 23. On January 15, BOE's Representative indicated that the parties reached a resolution and requested that the case been withdrawn.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

The pre-hearing conference is cancelled and the case is dismissed.
