FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUE:

Is the Student's current placement appropriate?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:

The Student is entitled to receive a free and appropriate public education in the least restrictive environment as defined in the Individuals with Disabilities Education Improvement Act ("IDEA") §20 U. S. C. 1401 et seq. and Connecticut General Statutes §10-76a et seq. The Parents filed the Due Process Hearing Complaint on February 25, 2020. The Hearing Officer was appointed on February 26, 2020. A Pre-Hearing conference was held on March 9, 2020 during which the Parent reported that matter had been settled. The Parents withdrew their complaint on March 9, 2020.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is DISMISSED.
