FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

The following issues have been identified for determination at the hearing:

- 1. Did the Board of Education deny the Student a Free Appropriate Public Education (FAPE) by modifying the Student's curriculum?
- 2. Did the Board of Education deny the Student FAPE by failing to provide prestudy and academic related vocabulary practice?
