### FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

#### **ISSUES:**

- 1. Was the Occupational Therapy Evaluation of the Student completed by the District appropriate?
- 2. If not, are the Parents entitled to an Independent Educational Evaluation ("IEE") in the area of Occupational Therapy at the District's expense?
