ISSUES:

- 1. Did the Board evaluate the Student in all areas of suspected disabilities?
- 2. Did the Board provide an appropriate placement?
- 3. Did the Board provide FAPE under 504?
- 4. What is the appropriate statute of limitations under IDEA and 504?
- 5. Is Grove School an appropriate placement?
- 6. Does the Student require a residential placement?
- 7. Should Student be placed at Grove School?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:

The Parent filed the Due Process Complaint and Request for Hearing on April 15, 2020. The Hearing Officer was appointed on April 16, 2020 and conducted a Prehearing Conference on May 7, 2020.
