FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

- 1. Did the Board provide Student with FAPE for the two years prior to the date of Due Process Complaint?
- 2. Did the Board evaluate the Student in all suspected areas of disabilities?
- 3. Did the Board consider parental input at PPTs?
- 4. Did the Board offer an appropriate program for the 2019-2020 school year and ESY 2020?
- 5. Did the Board commit procedural due process violations?
- 6. Is Forman School an appropriate placement, and if so, should the Board finally support Student's placement at Forman School?
- 7. Should the Parents be reimbursed for tuition and education related expenses for placement of the Student at Forman School?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:

The Parent filed the Due Process Complaint and Request for Hearing on May 14, 2020. The Hearing Officer was appointed on May 15, 2020 and conducted a Prehearing Conference on June 8, 2020. The parties reported that they were in the process of settling the dispute as a result of a Resolution meeting. On June 23, 2020, the Parent's attorney reported to the Hearing Officer that the Parents were withdrawing the Due Process Complaint with prejudice.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is **DISMISSED** with prejudice.
