FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

- 1. Did the Board provide FAPE for ESY 2020 and for the 2020-2021 school year?
- 2. Did the Board provide appropriate transition services?
- 3. If not, is Chapel Haven an appropriate placement?
- 4. If not, is Chapel Haven an appropriate placement?
- 5. If so, does Student require a residential placement?
- 6. If so, should the Student be placed at the residential placement at Chapel Haven?
- 7. Should Parents be reimbursed for their payment for the evaluation of Student by Dr. Hassan Minhas?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:

The Parent filed the Due Process Complaint and Request for Hearing on June 16, 2020. The Hearing Officer was appointed on June 17, 2020 and conducted a Prehearing Conference on July 10, 2020 at which time the parties reported that they had resolved the dispute in principle and were working on a settlement agreement. On August 15, 2020, the Parents withdrew the Due Process Complaint.
