FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

1. Did the Board provide FAPE for ESY 2020 and for the 2020-2021 school year?
2. Did the Board provide appropriate transition services?
3. If not, is Chapel Haven an appropriate placement?
4. If not, is Chapel Haven an appropriate placement?
5. If so, does Student require a residential placement?
6. If so, should the Student be placed at the residential placement at Chapel Haven?
7. Should Parents be reimbursed for their payment for the evaluation of Student by Dr. Hassan Minhas?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:

The Parent filed the Due Process Complaint and Request for Hearing on June 16, 2020. The Hearing Officer was appointed on June 17, 2020 and conducted a Prehearing Conference on July 10, 2020 at which time the parties reported that they had resolved the dispute in principle and were working on a settlement agreement. On August 15, 2020, the Parents withdrew the Due Process Complaint.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is **DISMISSED**.
