FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUE:

Should the IEP of the Student continue until his 22nd birthday?

SUMMARY AND PROCEDURAL HISTORY:

Case 20-0495 was commenced by the Parents by request received by the Board on June 17, 2020. A prehearing conference was held on July 9, 2020. At the prehearing conference, a hearing date was set for August 25, 2020 and the decision date was determined to be August 31, 2020. The hearing was later cancelled and the decision date extended to November 27, 2020.

On September 16, 2020, the undersigned hearing officer was advised by the attorney for the Parents that the parties had reached a settlement in the case and the matter should therefore be dismissed without prejudice.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is dismissed without prejudice.
