# FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

### **ISSUES:**

- 1. Did the District offer a free and appropriate public education (FAPE) for ESY 2020?
- 2. Did the District offer a free and appropriate public education (FAPE) for the 2020-2021 school year?
- 3. If the answer to #2 is "no", should the Board place the Student at The Southport School for the 2020-2021 school year?
- 4. Should the District reimburse the parents for outside speech services?
- 5. Does the hearing officer have jurisdiction over the Rehabilitation Act claim?
- 6. Does the hearing officer have jurisdiction over the Americans with Disabilities Act claim?

## **PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:**

The Parents filed their Due Process Complaint and Request for Hearing on July 28, 2020. The Hearing Officer was appointed on July 29, 2020. A Prehearing Conference was noticed for and held on August 26, 2020. On September 9, 2020, via email, the Attorney for the parents withdrew their request for a Due Process Hearing based on the settlement of this matter and requested that it be dismissed with prejudice.
