FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

- 1. Was the Student denied FAPE for the 2018-2019 and 2019-2020 school years?
- 2. If not, is placement at the Institute of Professional Practice International School (IPPI) in Naugatuck the appropriate program for the Student for the 2020-2021 school year?
- 3. Is the Student entitled to compensatory education and/or any other remedy deemed to be appropriate by the Hearing Officer?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:

The Parents filed the Due Process Complaint and Request for Hearing on August 7, 2020. The Hearing Officer was appointed on August 11, 2020. A Prehearing Conference was scheduled for August 20, 2020. A hearing date was scheduled October 14, 2020. Extensions were subsequently granted to allow the parties to attempt a settlement. The Hearing Officer was notified by counsel for the parents via email on January 14, 2021 that they were withdrawing their request for a Due Process Hearing.
