ISSUE:

Are the assessments conducted by the Board as part of the triennial review appropriate?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:

The Student is entitled to receive a free and appropriate public education in the least restrictive environment as defined in the Individuals with Disabilities Education Improvement Act (“IDEA”) §20 U. S. C. 1401 et seq. and Connecticut General Statutes §10-76a et seq. The Student initiated this special education due process case on August 18, 2020. The Hearing Officer was appointed on August 19, 2020. Pre-hearing conference was noticed on September 2, 2020. On September 3, 2020, the Board withdrew the request for due process.

The matter is DISMISSED
