FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

1. Did the Board offer an appropriate program for the 2020-2021 school year?
2. If not, is placement at Prism the appropriate program for the Student for the 2020-21 school year and should the Board be ordered to place the Student at Prism for the 2020-21 school year?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:

The Parents filed their Due Process Complaint and Request for Hearing on August 25, 2020. The Hearing Officer was appointed on the same date. A Prehearing Conference was noticed for and held on September 9, 2020. On September 29, 2021, via email, the attorney for the Student withdrew the request for a Due Process Hearing based on the settlement of this matter and requested that it be dismissed with prejudice.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

In light of the above, the matter is **DISMISSED**.
