FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

1. Was the psychological evaluation appropriate?
2. Was the educational evaluation appropriate?
3. If either or both of the evaluations were not appropriate, should the District be ordered to provide a psychoeducational IEE at public expense?

SUMMARY AND PROCEDURAL HISTORY:

Case 21-0173 was commenced by the District on November 4, 2020. A prehearing conference was held on November 17, 2020. At the prehearing conference, a hearing date was set for January 6, 2021 and the decision date was determined to be December 18, 2020. The hearing was subsequently cancelled and the decision date extended to May 18, 2021.

On April 14, 2021, the undersigned hearing officer was advised by the attorneys for the parties that the parties had reached a resolution and that both the underlying IEE request and the request for due process were being withdrawn with prejudice.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is dismissed with prejudice.
