## FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

### **ISSUES:**

- 1. Did the District develop an IEP for the 2020-2021 school year that provided FAPE?
- 2. Did the District follow the Department of Education's Policy Guidance Letters dated March 24, 2020 and/or April 24, 2020 regarding COVID-19 and the provisions of IDEA to ensure parental participation and scheduling of timely PPT meetings?
- 3. Did the District fail to implement the 2019-2020 IEP regarding evaluations and if so, did that failure deny the Student FAPE?
- 4. Did the District deprive the Parents of their rights in the development of the Student's 2020-21 school year IEP program and placement?
- 5. Are the Parents entitled to reimbursement for the costs of Winston Preparatory School, including tuition and transportation for the 2020-2021 school year?
- 6. Did the District comply with the procedural requirements set forth in the IDEA and applicable special education statutes with respect to the development of the Student's 2020-21 school year IEP and the provision of FAPE during the 2020-21 school years?
- 7. Is the Student entitled to compensatory education services as an equitable remedy?

### **PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:**

The Parents filed their Due Process Complaint and Request for Hearing on December 8, 2020. The Hearing Officer was appointed on December 8, 2020. A Prehearing Conference was noticed for and held on December 31, 2020. On February 2, 2021, via email, the Attorney for the Parents withdrew

their request for a Due Process Hearing based on the resolution of this matter and requested that it be dismissed without prejudice.

# **FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:**

In light of the above, the matter is **DISMISSED**.
