- 1. Is the Psychoeducational Evaluation appropriate?
- 2. If not, are the Parents entitled to an independent psychoeducational evaluation at public expense?
- 3. Is the Occupational Therapy Evaluation appropriate?
- 4. If not, are the Parents entitled to an IEE in the area of occupational therapy at public expense?
