



#### 2024 LAS Results




- The 2024 Form E LAS Links results are now final in <u>DRC's INSIGHT</u> secure portal.

#### **PSIS** Reminders



The Public School Information System (PSIS) drives information about students in TIDE.

- The PSIS Testing Demographics for SPED, FRL, EL, Military Family, and Homeless values were loaded in November 2023.
- The values for Recently Arrived EL and Section 504 were not pulled from Freeze Zero. These must be set in the PSIS Registration Module.
- Student demographic values will be saved, and the fields locked in PSIS on May 31, 2024. All changes to a student's status at the time of testing must be made by May 31, 2024.
- Student's grade in PSIS is that grade in which the test is given.
- Accommodations are available only to students recorded in PSIS as Special Education or Section 504.



#### **Appeals**



- Page 56 in the <u>TIDE User Guide</u> explains the appeals process.
  - If a test is paused and needs to be reopened, the appeal is for a Grace Period Extension.
  - If a test is submitted and needs to be reopened, the appeal is for a Reopen Test.
- Appeal requests cannot be processed if the student is in the test at the time the appeal is being approved.

#### **Participation Reminders**



Participation expectations for Smarter Balanced, NGSS, and Connecticut SAT School Day include testing all students:

- Enrolled in the Public School Information System (PSIS) in Grades 3-8 and
   11.
- Enrolled in PSIS attending Approved Private Special Education Programs (APSEPs).
- Enrolled in PSIS who are being educated in out-of-state facilities, in-state facilities, and non-approved facilities.

#### **MONITORING TEST PROGRESS**

#### TEST STATUS CODE REPORT AND TEST COMPLETION RATES

This document provides instructions for generating Test Status Code Reports and Test Completion Rates in the Test Information Distribution Engine (TIDE). Either report may be used by school- and district-level users to monitor test progress for the following assessments in the Connecticut Comprehensive Assessment Program: Smarter Balanced Summative Assessments, Smarter Balanced Interim Assessments (IABs and ICAs), Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS) Summative Assessments, NGSS Interim Assessments, Connecticut Alternate Assessment of English Language Proficiency (CAAELP). Each type of report is explained in the pages that follow. The following chart outlines the user roles associated with various permissions to access each type of report in TIDE:

#### **Test Status Code Report**



- Specific report used to view each student's test status and all special codes to explain a student's non-participation in a test.
- Displays all test statuses for each test for which each student in a district/school is eligible.
- May be generated at the district level or at the school level, depending on your user role.
- Report should be generated for each test to obtain an accurate picture reflecting the testing status of all students for all tests in the school or district.



#### **Test Completion Rates**



- High-level reports used to summarize the number and percentage of students who have started or completed a test.
- May be generated at the district or school level, depending on your user role.
- All students in the specified school or district will be included in this report.
- Report should be generated for each test to obtain an accurate picture that reflects the testing status of all students for all tests in the school or district.
- Users will be able to view test completion data by combo tests (e.g., completion of both the Math CAT and Math PT).



#### Results



- All results (NGSS, Smarter, CTAS, CTAA and CAAELP) will be posted by mid-June.
- CSDE will likely be providing results taken earlier in the window on a "rolling release" in the <a href="Centralized Reporting System">Centralized Reporting System</a> (CRS).
- This will be dependent on the quality control process. The tentative date is set for Mid-May.



#### **CT-SEDS and TIDE**




If you notice accommodations are not populating from CT-SEDS to TIDE, check the following:

 Verify the plan has been finalized and implemented(begin date) in CT-SEDS.



- Ensure that the implemented plan covers the current grade of enrollment.
- Check the IDEA or 504 Indicator in TIDE. It must be activated for accommodations to sync.\*
- Review the student's SASID in CT-SEDS to ensure that it is a legitimate SASID aligned to PSIS/TIDE.\*
