



District Assessment Audit Webinar Series

All Connecticut school districts completed the state's comprehensive [audit](#) of district assessments in early 2025. **All district and school leaders are strongly encouraged to register for a 2-part webinar series** to learn about the state audit findings and how to understand, interpret, and act on their District-Specific Assessment Inventory Reports. **The district-specific reports will be provided to Superintendents by March 2, 2026.** This webinar series kicks off a new, multi-year state initiative: **Student-Centered Assessment for Learning (SCALE)**. SCALE is a statewide professional learning, coaching, and technical assistance program to strengthen the capacity of teachers and leaders to design, implement, and sustain balanced (or sensible) assessment systems that accelerate student learning.

Webinar 1 will provide the background for the district assessment audit, review state-level findings and implications, connect findings to key assessment best practices, and explain district-specific assessment audit reports and the reflection tool. Leaders will leave the webinar with all they need to complete the district reflection tool on their local results.
