

NGSS Summative Testing

•In the TA interface, tests are now broken out by English, Braille, and

Spanish.



- •For example, if a student has Spanish presentation set in TIDE, the student should be administered the Spanish Science test.
- •If a student logs in and sees the message "No Test Found", please verify that the student has the proper test settings selected in TIDE.
- •If there are students in a classroom who will be taking Braille, Spanish, or English tests, the teacher can administer all three tests at the same time. Select all appropriate tests before starting a session.

Text-to-Speech of ELA Reading Passages

If a student is eligible for Text-to-Speech of ELA Reading Passages (see the 2021-22 Decision Guidelines for Text-to-Speech of Smarter Balanced ELA Reading Passages), be sure to set the TIDE permissions to Passages & Items (Accommodations).



When the student takes the ELA Reading Assessment, the student should select the context menu and choose **Speak**Passage (as shown on the right). The text will highlight as the text is read aloud.

Text-to-Speech of Test Items

Prior to testing, set Text-to-Speech of **Items** (for ELA) or **Stimuli & Items** (for math and science) on the TIDE dashboard, as shown below.



Text-to-Speech of Test Items

To listen to a question or answer options, students open the question context menu and select one of the following Speak options:

- ⇒ To listen only to the question, students select Speak Question.
- ⇒ To listen to a multiple-choice question and all answer options, students select Speak Question and Options.
- ⇒ To listen only to an answer option, select **Speak Option** from the context menu and then select the answer option. Students could also right-click the answer option and select **Speak Option**.
- ⇒ To listen to a specific portion of text, highlight the text you would like to listen to. Right-click the highlighted text and select Speak Selection.



TIDE Test Setting Reminders

- Careful attention must be given to activate designated supports and accommodations prior to testing.
- Supports and accommodations added to TIDE after a student begins testing will not work and are not retroactive.
- Students testing without accommodations (or with the wrong accommodations) are considered test irregularities and must be reported through the Appeal System in TIDE.
- All students should have an opportunity to take a <u>Practice</u>
 <u>Test</u> to learn the test platform and available universal tools.
 Students with designated supports and accommodations should know how to use these accessibility features prior to test day.







For Late Eligibility Form Submissions
