
### Materials/TIDE/Field Testing

- All materials posted to the Connecticut Comprehensive Assessment Program Portal:
  - https://ct.portal.cambiumast.com/
- Paper TAMs/TCM were delivered in late January. If your district did not receive them or need more, please contact the Cambium Help Desk.
- Connecticut is participating in field testing for Smarter Balanced and NGSS.
- CSDE will very likely be providing results taken earlier in window on a "rolling release" during the window in CRS. This will be dependent on Quality Control process, so a hard date has not been set.



### **NGSS Summative Testing**

•In the TA interface, the tests are now broken out by English, Braille and Spanish.



- •For example, if a student has Spanish set in TIDE, the student should be administered the Spanish Science test.
- •If a student logs in and sees the message "No Test Found", please verify that the student has the proper test settings selected in TIDE.
- •If there are students in a classroom who will be taking Braille, Spanish or English tests, the teacher can administer all three tests at the same time. Just select all the appropriate tests before starting a test session.

- ✓ District Administrators should contact Deirdre Ducharme (860) 713-6859 for students requiring non-standard accommodations (e.g., human reader, signer, scribe, math manipulatives)
- ✓ Requests for Medical Exemptions have specific deadlines based on test windows:
  - ☐ Connecticut SAT School Day-June 10, 2022
  - ☐ Smarter Balanced, NGSS, Connecticut Alternate Assessments- June 10, 2022
  - ☐ Refer to Appendix B of the <u>Assessment Guidelines</u> for more information.

### **Preparation Reminders**

- ☐ Prepare the test setting (e.g., small group, lighting, testing devices, assistive technology, etc.).
- □ Set up a practice test experience for all students and model how to use universal tools, designated supports, and accommodations with those students using them.
- Order paper materials (Large Print and Braille) in TIDE (DAonly function).

### Reader Supports and Accommodations

Reader supports are provided by Text-to-Speech (TSS) (embedded) or by a human Reader (non-embedded).

- TSS is available as a designated support for test items (ELA) and stimuli and items (Math and NGSS)
- TSS is available as an accommodation for the ELA Reading Passages for eligible students. Refer to the:
  - Connecticut Smarter Balanced and NGSS Reader Options Table
  - ➤ <u>Decision Guidelines for Text-to-Speech of the Smarter Balanced</u> <u>ELA Reading Passages</u>
- The accommodation for a Human Reader or Human Signer is available through the submission of a petition for special documented accommodations.

### Data Entry Interface (DEI)




## To qualify for the Connecticut Alternate Assessment System:

- PPT decision guided by the Connecticut Alternate Assessment Eligibility Form
- Eligibility Form must be submitted through the Data Entry Interface by the trained TEA

### **Secure Alternate Assessment Materials**




- Secure Test Materials can only be accessed by a trained TFA.
- Materials are posted to TIDE prior to March 28.
- Resources include:
  - Secure Directions for Test Administration (DTAs)
     (grade and subject specific) Required
  - □ Secure PDFs of the CTAA Math and ELA (grade specific)
  - □ All materials must be securely stored when not in use
  - □ Requires secure shredding upon completion






# Reminder about CTAA Test Administration

- CTAA User Guide provides step-by-step instructions for test administration
- Two testing devices are needed:
  - TEA will use one computer device to access the Test Administration Interface
  - TEA will use second device for the teacher/student to access the <u>Secure Browser</u> (must be downloaded to student device)








# Connecticut Alternate Science (CTAS) Grades 5, 8, and 11

- The CTAS is non-secure and can be administered flexibly throughout the school year by the trained TEA.
- CTAS Required Test Materials were mailed to DAs in 2018 but are posted to the portal. Resources include:
  - ☐ Grade-Specific Performance Tasks
  - □ Resource Packets (require organization and assembly)
  - ☐ Student Score Worksheets
- Student Score Worksheets must be submitted by the trained TEA in the Data Entry Interface by June 3, 2022.
