Individual Student Report Electronic Distribution May 28, 2025, 3 p.m.

Beginning in 2027, the CSDE Performance Office will be distributing student score reports for Smarter Balanced, NGSS, and the Connecticut Alternate Assessments exclusively in a PDF format (not in paper format) so districts can then distribute them electronically. The Performance Office has been distributing these student score reports in PDF for several years and some districts have been distributing reports to parents electronically via tools such as ParentSquare, SchoolMessenger, PowerSchool Parent Portal, Infinite Campus Digital Backpack, and Conductor Plus. 

Text-to-Speech in Spanish with Spanish Toggle for Math and Science



- For eligible students who are dually identified as EL/ML, teams should document the text-tospeech and Spanish Toggle on the state assessment page of the plan. These supports will sync to TIDE when the plan is finalized and implemented.
- For eligible students without IEPs/Section 504
 Plans, set Text-to-Speech to Stimuli & Items
 for Science and set presentation to Spanish
 Toggle in TIDE.
- Be sure that the Spanish voice pack is downloaded to the student's testing device prior to testing.
- These supports must be reflected in TIDE prior to testing. They will not work if added to TIDE after a student starts the math or NGSS assessment.





Administering Tests with English, Spanish or Braille Presentation



1. The test administrator must select the test from the menu. (Middle School is shown as an example. See below.) Then, select Start Session. These are the three available presentations. 3 Tests Selected Next Generation Science Standards Summative Assessments Choose the tests to add to your session, and then start your session Summative Grade 8 Science Summative Braille Grade 8 Science Summative Spanish Grade 8 Science Middle School + High School

Start Session

Depending on the student's test settings in TIDE, they will only see **one** option on their Secure Browser. For example:

Summative Grade 8 Science

OR

Summative Braille Grade 8 Science

OR

Summative Spanish Grade 8 Science

If the student sees the message "No Tests Available," the teacher will need to go back to the Test Administrator Interface to make sure all three tests appear in the right-portion of the screen.





Desmos Reminders for Math in Grades 6-8, Segment 1 and Performance Tasks



In the Classroom:

- Teach, learn, and explore mathematical concepts.
