Communications

The <u>Student Assessment News</u> is the primary source of communication regarding state-wide assessments for all Connecticut public school students. If you are not receiving this newsletter, please <u>register</u> for email updates from the Connecticut Comprehensive Assessment Program Portal at <u>https://ct.portal.cambiumast.com/</u>.

Communications related to the Smarter Balanced, Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS), the Connecticut SAT School Day, and Connecticut Alternate Assessments are posted to the <u>Connecticut</u> <u>Comprehensive Assessment Program Portal</u> and the Connecticut State Department of Education (CSDE) <u>Student Assessment</u> webpage.

Communications and relevant information related to students identified as English learners/multilingual learners (ELs/MLs) are posted on the CSDE English Language Proficiency Assessment webpage, while non-secure information related to the administration of the LAS Links assessment is posted on the Connecticut Data Recognition Corporation (DRC) LAS Links website.

Update User Roles and Contact Information

Please take time this summer to review and update user accounts and contact information related to each assessment system (e.g., TIDE, Data Recognition Corporation InSight Portal). Delete accounts for inactive users. Please reference the <u>Test Information Distribution Engine (TIDE) User Guide</u> regarding viewing, adding, editing and deleting user roles. (Note: these updates do not apply to the College Board's TIDE system. Details about the College Board's TIDE system is forthcoming.) New Alternate Assessment

Beginning with the 2022-23 school year, the CSDE will incorporate a new alternate assessment into the existing Connecticut Alternate Assessment System. The Collaborative for the Alternate Assessment of English Language Proficiency (CAAELP) is designed for students with the most significant cognitive disabilities in Grades K-12 who are dually identified as an ELs/MLs and receive services under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA). Eligible students, determined at each annual Planning and Placement Team (PPT) meeting, will participate in the appropriate assessment system now includes:

- The Connecticut Alternate Assessment (CTAA) for English Language Arts and Mathematics for eligible students in Grades 3-8 and 11; and
- The Connecticut Alternate Science (CTAS) Assessment for eligible students in Grades 5, 8, and 11; and
- The Collaborative for the Alternate Assessment of English Language Proficiency (CAAELP) for eligible ELs/MLs with the most significant cognitive disabilities in Grades K-12.

Updated Alternate Assessment Eligibility Form

The <u>Connecticut Alternate Assessment Eligibility Form</u>, and associated <u>resources</u>, have been revised for the 2022-23 school year to include the CAAELP. Please share these resources with relevant staff. Any eligibility determination for the Alternate Assessment System conducted during a PPT for the 2022-23 school year will use the updated Alternate Assessment System Eligibility Form. This form is also available in the Connecticut Special Education Data System (CT-SEDS).

As in the past, teachers are required to complete training each year to qualify for trained (TEA) status. In addition to permission to administer the alternate assessments, trained TEAs must register eligible students for participation in the Alternate Assessment System by submitting the 2022-23 Alternate Assessment System Eligibility Form into the Data Entry Interface (DEI) when it opens on November 14, 2022. Eligibility forms completed in CT-SEDS must also be entered in the DEI. Please note, strict adherence to the submission deadlines is expected. These deadlines allow the CSDE and local school districts to develop and populate the various student test files for each unique testing system. Missing these deadlines will potentially result in test irregularities and may have accountability implications.

Technology Preparations

Connecticut works closely with our test vendors to provide system enhancements and necessary updates to provide consistent access and security. Please be sure to watch for communications alerting districts to technology guidance, resources for system requirements, training, and secure browser information on the DRC INSIGHT Portal, the Connecticut DRC LAS Links Website, the Connecticut Student Assessment Website, College Board TIDE, and the Connecticut Comprehensive Assessment Program Website. This information should be shared with appropriate technology staff.
