**SUBJECT:** Connecticut Alternate Science Assessment Field Test

This communication provides additional clarification supporting the memorandum sent from Commissioner Dr. Dianna R. Wentzell to Superintendents on <u>February 13, 2018</u>, pertaining to the Connecticut Alternate Science Assessment (CTAS) Field Test. That memo outlined important milestones and provided context to the development of this new assessment being developed by the Performance Office in the Connecticut State Department of Education (CSDE).

The CSDE will be field testing the new CTAS this spring. Students eligible for the Connecticut Alternate Assessment (CTAA) who are in Grades 5, 8, or 11 are expected to participate in this CTAS Field Test. Following the testing window, the CSDE will review item-performance data. Therefore, in 2018, districts will not receive performance results on the CTAS Field Test. However, districts will be accountable for participation for all eligible students.

For the 2018 CTAS Field Test, trained teachers will administer an assigned portion of the assessment (either Form 1 or Form 2) to eligible students in Grades 5, 8, and 11. Trained Teachers Administering the Alternate (TEAs) must record student ratings for the CTAS Field Test. The TEAs must also submit these student ratings in the Data Entry Interface (DEI) during the submission window from **April 30, 2018,** to **May 25, 2018.**
