SUBJECT: Science Waiver Approval and Revised Summative Calendar

The U.S. Department of Education has approved Connecticut's waiver request related to statewide student assessment in science. As a result, in spring 2018, the Connecticut State Department of Education (CSDE) will only administer a Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS) Assessment Field Test for both the science standard and alternate assessments in Grades 5 and 8 in lieu of the CMT Science and the CMT Skills Checklist Science. The CSDE already planned, as permitted under current law, to not administer the CAPT and CAPT Skills Checklist Science to 10th graders in spring 2018 because those students will take the new NGSS assessment as 11th graders in spring 2019.

In light of this waiver, no science assessment results will be issued for 2017-18 for students, schools, or districts. However, the CSDE will hold districts and schools accountable for *participation* on the NGSS Assessment Field Test. The Summative Assessment Calendar below for 2017-18 has been revised to reflect these changes.
