

Accommodations Crosswalk for Connecticut SAT School Day



This crosswalk has been designed to help educators understand the relationship between the College Board options in SSD Online and SAT School Day accommodation in the CAI system. Although the Connecticut SAT is being administered digitally, SSD Online is still aligned to paper-based College Board assessments. Therefore, additional notes about how students will test digitally are included. The paper-based SAT is only allowed for students that require a paper assessment as documented in their plan. It is recommended that you have students take a practice test to try out their digital accommodations to ensure the best options are in place.

Large Print Test Book	Students can use universal Zoom tool up to 51-pt. font. Test settings in TIDE should be adjusted for font greater than 51-pt. (if student's access needs cannot be met using the digital Zoom, large print test booklets can be ordered through College Board.)	Documentation is required for any request larger than 20-pt.
Human Reader	Can the student's access needs be met through text-to-speech technology? If so, student will use text-to-speech (TSS). If the student cannot use TSS through the online test delivery system, the student will use a human reader. Students who require a human reader should take the paper SAT and not test digitally.	Student must test in a one-to-one setting with the human reader for the entire assessment. Automatically receives time and one-half when using a human reader. A specialized reader script will be sent for the proctor.

Pre-recorded audio (MP3 via streaming)	Student will use text-to-speech. Set TTS – Read Text Only (automatically time and one-half) or TTS – Read Text and Graphics (automatically double time) depending on the student’s need.	Students may test in groups if wearing headphones. Will automatically receive double time with additional time on the writing and language test.
Braille with raised line drawings	Student will utilize appropriate assistive technology. Adjust TIDE test settings for assistive technology and set permissive mode to “on”.	College Board provides UEB with Nemeth Math
Raised line drawings (graphs and figures)	Student will utilize appropriate assistive technology. Adjust TIDE test settings for assistive technology and set permissive mode to “on”.	Students approved for braille don’t need this accommodation because raised line drawings are included with the braille test book.
Magnification device (non-electronic)	Students can use universal Zoom tool up to 51-pt. font. Test settings in TIDE should be adjusted for font greater than 51-pt.	Students must provide their own device.
Magnification device (electronic)	Students can use universal Zoom tool up to 51-pt. font. Test settings in TIDE should be adjusted for font greater than 51-pt.	Devices that pose security risks or test validity issues are not permitted.
Colored overlay	Color contrast set in TIDE	School or student must provide the overlay.
Assistive technology compatible (ATC) test format (Provides digital version of the test delivered on a flash drive for use with screen readers)	Student may use assistive technology or universal Zoom tool in TIDE. Permissive mode must be set to “on”.	Student must be approved for both the ATC and the assistive technology they intend to use, such as a screen reader, prior to test day.

Large-print (large-block) answer sheet (no bubbles)	If large-print (large block) answer sheet (no bubbles) is chosen as the related accommodation provided in school, the student should take the paper SAT.	When a large print test book is requested, a large print answer sheet is also included. The student may only use the large print answer sheet if approved in SSD Online.
Computer (word processor ONLY for Essays ONLY)	Not applicable to the Connecticut SAT	Not applicable to the Connecticut SAT
Writer/scribe to record responses*	Assistive technology (speech-to-text) can be used and set in TIDE and set permissive mode to “on”.	Must test in a one-to-one setting and will automatically receive time and one-half.
Writer/scribe to record responses*	Set non-embedded accommodation in TIDE. NOTE: This is applicable only to students who state or point to their responses.	Must test in a one-to-one setting and will automatically receive time and one-half.
