

EL Supports

 PSAT/NMSQT will now be available for students using supports for English learners.

 EL supports are now available for the full SAT School Day Suite.

 Supports should be requested ~4 weeks before testing.

Saturday Testing



College Board will provide support for 2 Saturday test dates in the fall of 2024 only.

- Oct 12 coincides with Yom Kippur
- Oct 26 will also be offered for those who have a conflict due to the holiday.



System Timing Updates

 Reduced from 2 business days, data will be available within 1 (24 hours) business day.

Examples:

- Once registered, student data will be present in Test Day Toolkit the following business day.
- Retests submitted through Test Day Toolkit will be ready the following business day.



System Timing Updates





Answer Submission

Answer Submission

- If a school has unsubmitted students, they will be notified the day after the test which students require additional action.
- If a school does not take action, 3 days after testing the College Board will automatically submit students.
- This will ensure that schools receive timely information if a student needs to retest.



Dismissal Procedures



- Based on feedback, more formal student dismissal procedures have been added to the Proctor Guide and Coordinator Manual.
- The directions will help reduce distractions and identify students who have encountered submission issues before they leave the room.



Dismissal Procedures

- At the start of testing, staff tell students that they may not leave until they are dismissed.
- Active monitoring includes ensuring that students are actively testing (no heads down, laptop shut).
- As test time winds down, staff will use Test Day Toolkit to identify any students who are not in a submitted state.
 - Students who have successfully submitted can be dismissed
 - Students who have not submitted will stay behind for troubleshooting.




Bluebook and Test Day Toolkit Updates



Bluebook Updates: Highlights & Notes Universal Tool

The Bluebook annotation tool has been improved to address student feedback and is called **Highlights & Notes**. It is now available in Bluebook for students to practice and will be part of fall testing administrations.








Bluebook Updates: Device check will include test of device lock

Beginning this fall, a student testing on a Mac laptop or iPad will see an additional screen during the exam setup flow. The intent of this screen is to confirm that their device can successfully be locked prior to test day.










Bluebook Updates: SAT Score Sends included in Exam Setup

Students continue to select their four free score sends as part of the exam setup flow for the SAT School Day exam.








Bluebook Updates: 2nd PSAT/NMSQT and PSAT 8/9 practice tests








Test Day Toolkit Updates: Student Data Download

Test coordinators can download a student room roster from Test Day Toolkit. This download includes room assignment, exam setup and testing status.






For all assessments, test coordinators will be able to generate a printable room directory that can be used to help direct students to testing rooms during check-in.










Test Day Toolkit Updates: All Students Page Customization

They can also select which columns are displayed, including a new addition, Exam Setup.










Proctor Approval of Student Re-entry into Testing

Beginning this fall, for all assessments, a student will need to indicate their reason for exiting Bluebook and their proctor will need to approve a student's re-entry into the test after an exit, crash or device swap.



- New eligibility letter that explains applicability of approved accommodations and how they will be provided
- Auto-generated when a merge has been processed





Testing Staff Roles and Responsibilities

Test Coordinator

- Validates student registration data and submits test orders
- Identifies staff to support test administration, ensures they have access to training and resources
- Oversees planning and test day activities for ALL students, including those with accommodations
- Works with technology staff to ensure devices being used for testing meet technical requirements and Bluebook is installed
- Reviews and submits Irregularity Reports







Technology Monitor*

- New required role for digital testing
- Assists students and staff with technical troubleshooting in the help room on test day

*Technical expertise is not required for this role

Proctor

- Starts and monitors the test using Test Day Toolkit
- Complete printed seating chart
- Observes the room, helps students, keeps room free of distraction
- Reports irregularities in Test Day Toolkit

Room/Hall Monitor

- Monitors rooms and hallways; provides relief to proctors.
- Directs students to help room, break area, restroom



Digital SAT Practice



Digital SAT Practice in Bluebook



Test Preview

A short set of untimed questions lets students experience digital testing and try out the tools. They won't receive scores or any feedback on their answers.



Full-Length Practice Test

Full-length practice tests are timed like a real test and include all the tools available to students on the actual tests. Students are also scored just as they would on the real thing.







My Practice



After completing the full-length practice test, students can sign in to **My Practice** to view their results.

- View practice score results and practice exam questions, answers, and explanations.
- Access progress bars representing knowledge of all the content domains on the test.
- Use practice test scores to filter questions in the Question Bank by domain, skill, and difficulty, allowing targeted practice in areas with the most opportunity to grow.
- Generate a set of Practice Specific Questions based on practice test results to provide additional review in the areas with the greatest opportunities for improvement.






Student Scores on the PSAT-Related Assessments

What is the AP Potential Tool?





- Free, online tool that allows schools to generate rosters of students who are likely to score a 3 or higher on a given AP[®] Exam
- Based on students' performance on the PSAT/NMSQT®, PSAT™ 8/9, PSAT™ 10, or SAT®
- Research driven:
 - Moderate to strong correlations exist between SAT Suite scores and AP Exam results
 - SAT Suite scores are stronger predictors of students' AP Exam scores than the more traditional factors such as high school grades and grades in samediscipline coursework






AP Potential
