New SSD Coordinators

Requesting Initial Access

To request initial access to SSD Online:

- The school/program must have an [Attending Institution \(AI\) Code](#)
 - For state-contracted testing, contact CSDE if your school/program does not have an AI Code
- New SSD coordinators must:
 - Have a [College Board professional educator account](#)
 - Complete and submit the [online SSD Coordinator Form](#). Please note that:
 - ▶ Part of completion is to “upload written approval from your school administrator” (instructions provided).
 - ▶ College Board will verify the requestor’s affiliation using the school’s online staff directory and/or contacting the approving school administrator. Access may be affected if responses are unclear or not provided.

Please note:

- Access is normally granted within five business days after submission
- Each school/program must have one Primary SSD Coordinator but may have multiple if permitted by district/school policy.

Submitting a New Request in SSD Online

Multi-Step Process

1. Choose type of accommodation or support
2. Confirm parent/guardian consent
3. Locate student or create new record
4. Select disabilities
5. Select accommodation(s)
6. Provide information about the student's school plan
7. Provide documentation, if requested
8. Complete submission

Select New Accommodation / Support Type

College Board (CB) Approved Accommodation

Accommodations for students with documented disabilities are available for all College Board tests. When College Board accommodations are used, students receive college and scholarship reportable scores. With limited exceptions, approved accommodations apply to all tests and do not need to be re-requested.

English Learner (EL) Support

EL supports are available for eligible students taking the PSAT 8/9, PSAT 10, PSAT/NMSQT, and SAT School Day assessments. Eligible students meet EL criteria defined by their state or by federal policy, be enrolled in an elementary or secondary school in the U.S. or U.S. territories, and use the same supports for classroom assessments. Only the EL support of time and one-half needs to be entered into SSD Online.

Temporary Conditions Support (TS)

Testing support for students with temporary impairments (caused by recent injury, accident, etc.) who cannot postpone their tests. Temporary supports are available for the following tests only: Weekend SAT® (seniors only), SAT School Day (seniors only), Advanced Placement® (AP) Exams, and state-provided PSAT 8/9, PSAT 10, and SAT School Day.



Exchange Accommodations in SSD Online

Reminder

- SSD Coordinators can now easily exchange certain accommodations themselves in SSD Online.
- Processing time reduced from up to **7 weeks** to about **15 minutes**.

No College Board review required for eligible exchanges

1. Coordinator goes to the **Student's Profile** in SSD Online.
2. Under **Actions**, select **Exchange Approved Accommodation**.
3. Choose the accommodation to remove and select a replacement.
4. Confirm parent consent, review details, and submit.
5. Within ~15 minutes: The eligible approved accommodation is marked *Removed*, what it was exchanged to is marked *Approved*, and a new decision letter is posted to the student's file.


Waiving Accommodations

What to do if a student wants to waive an accommodation for this test only


- If a student has approved accommodations in their SSD Online profile but does not want to use them for the Spring 2026 SAT School Day, the STC or SSD Coordinator can waive their accommodations in SDMS.
 - Waiving a student's accommodation(s) in SDMS applies to the Spring 2026 administration only.
 - To remove an accommodation from a student's profile entirely for all College Board assessments, remove the accommodation(s) in SSD Online.
- Prior to waiving any accommodations in SDMS, we recommend that the school obtain instructions in writing from the student's parent/guardian or the student (if 18 or older) regarding which accommodations to waive.
- Accommodations must be waived no later than 2 days prior to the student's digital test date to make sure the student's test package is configured properly. Students testing using a paper testing accommodation will need to have their accommodations waived no later than 4 days prior to their test date to ensure the correct paper testing materials can be shipped to the school.

How to Waive a Student's Accommodation

- Use the filters on the left or scroll through the roster, then click the + sign to expand the student record and scroll to the Testing Information section.
- Scroll to the section that displays the student's testing accommodations and click the checkbox "Waive Accommodations"
- Slide to the right the toggle button next to the specific accommodation the student does not want and press the blue Save button to apply the change.
- If a student changes their mind, you can use the toggle button to reinstate the accommodation.





Ending Extended Time Early

Students with extended time (time and one-half, double time, or more) will have the option of moving to the next part of the test before their full extended time expires, **once the standard testing time has passed**. While students are encouraged to use all the time they need and are approved for, they won't be required to stay for their full extended time if they finish testing or ready to move on.

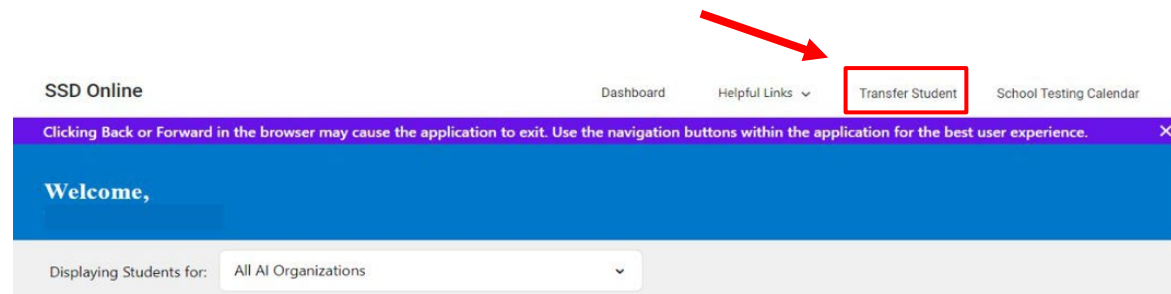

In SSD Online, select Transfer Student and follow prompts to complete



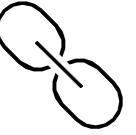
Manage Requests
