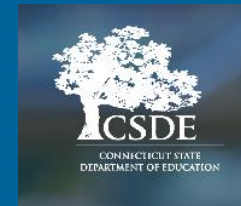

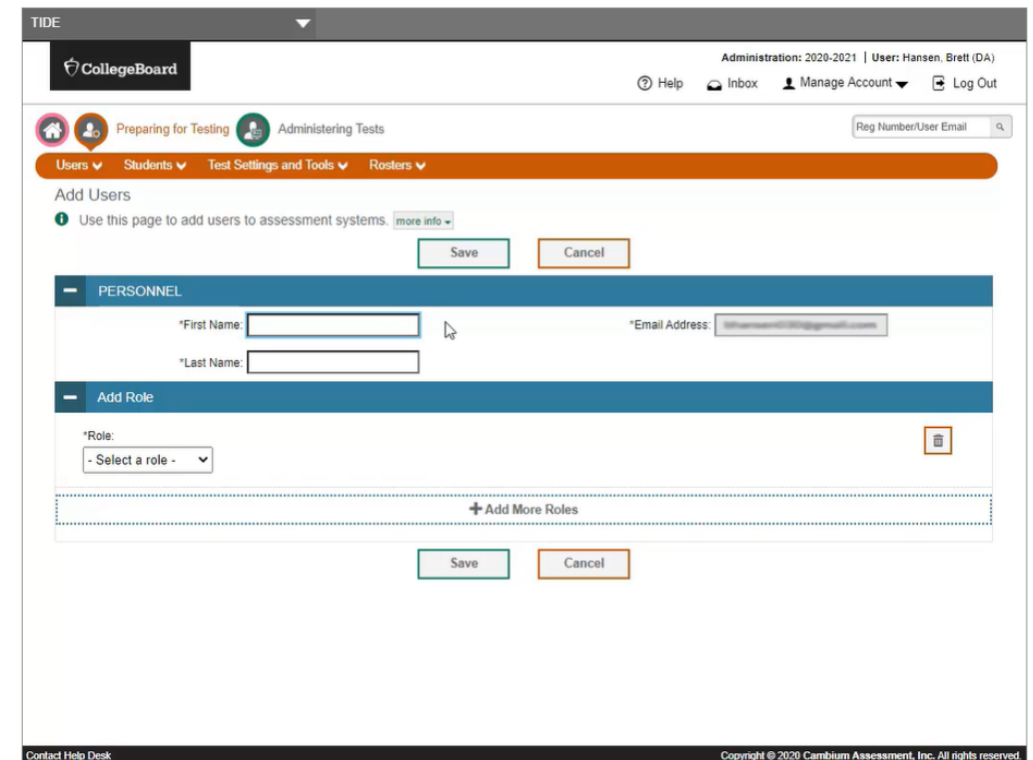
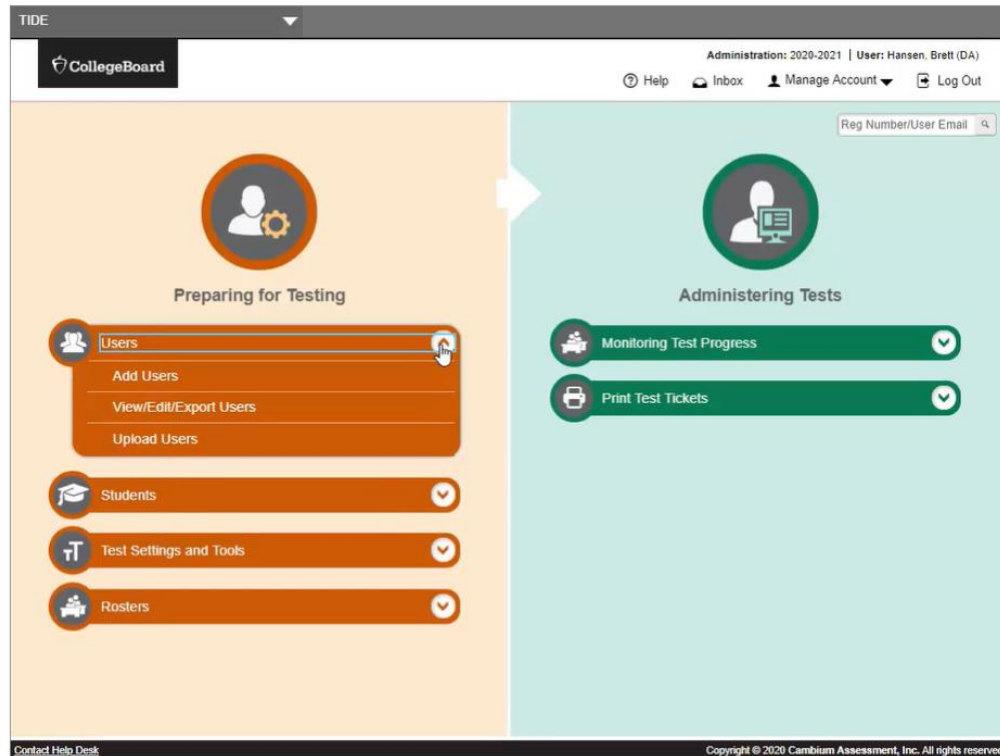

Nonstandard Administration Report (NAR)

- Use the “Test Window” column to identify students testing during the accommodated window.
- Identifies students who can test in the same testing room.
- Indicates the color test book to administer
- Use the accommodated manuals to identify which test script to read and any additional instructions.

Paper Test Book as an Accommodation

- Some students may test with accommodations (i.e., paper or braille test book) that are not appropriate for a digital test. If this is the case, the student may choose to opt out of testing in the digital mode and test with a paper-based test.
- Proctors will follow the instructions in the paper test administration manual for Connecticut SAT School Day.

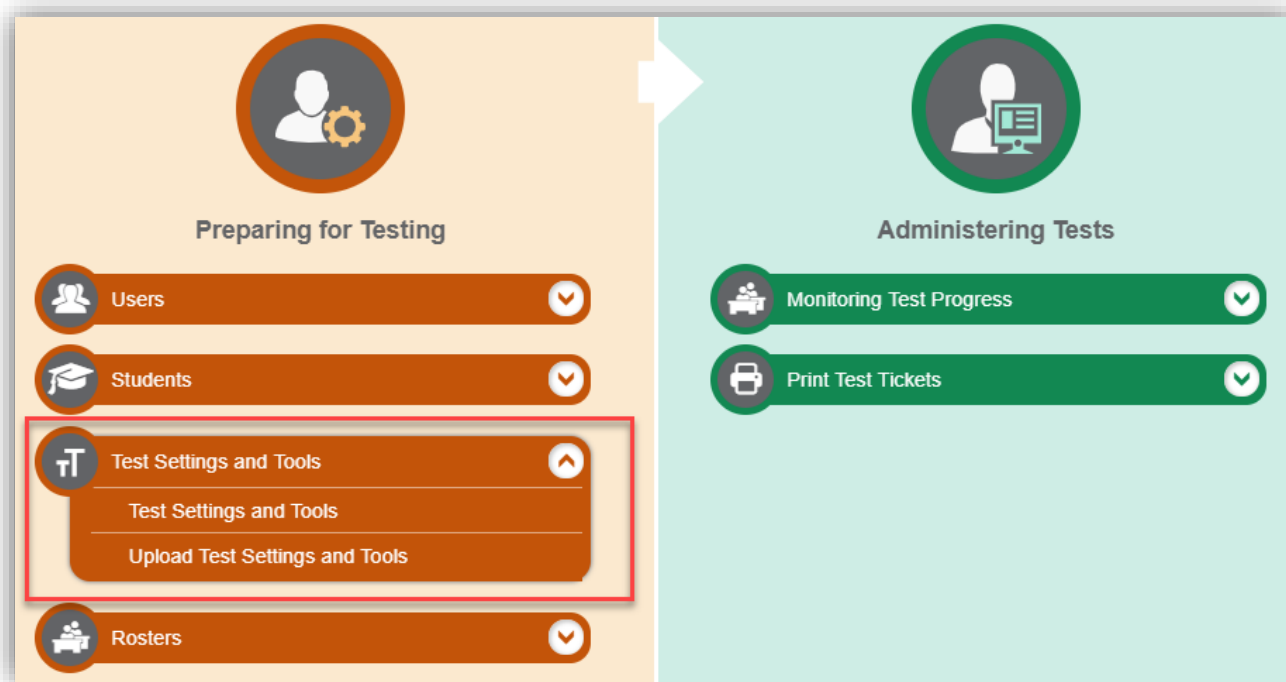

- All students taking the Connecticut SAT digital assessment must use the secure browser. Digital alternatives for College Board-approved accommodations must be enabled in TIDE before test day.
- The **Test Settings and Tools** menu allows the test coordinators and SSD coordinators to view and edit accessibility features and accommodations for students approved to test with an accommodation and/or EL support.






