This resource provides guidance to Connecticut school district personnel who must make decisions about testing special student populations on the Smarter Balanced Assessments, Connecticut Mastery Test (CMT) Science, the Connecticut Academic Performance Test (CAPT) Science, CMT Skills Checklist Science, the CAPT Skills Checklist Science, and the Connecticut Alternate Assessment (CTAA). These special student populations include students identified as eligible for special education services under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), students identified as disabled under Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and students who are identified as English Learners (EL). This decision making also includes general education students who may require additional supports.

Verification of Information

Upcoming Smarter Balanced Webinars

Technology Webinar

A new secure browser will need to be installed on testing computers for the 2016-17 administration of the Smarter Balanced Assessments. The Connecticut State Department of Education (CSDE) and American Institutes for Research (AIR) will be hosting a webinar that will cover details related to this installation, as well as other technological requirements for testing this year and necessary information about voice packs for those needing the text-to-speech accommodation. This webinar is appropriate for technology coordinators and any school staff responsible for preparing computers for online test administrations.

Live training will occur on Wednesday, <u>September 28, 2016, 2:15 – 3:00 p.m. ET</u>. **To register, click on the date.** After registering, a confirmation e-mail containing information about joining the webinar will be sent to the e-mail address you provided during registration.

TIDE Webinar

An improved version of the Test Information and Distribution Engine (TIDE) will be released on October 6. Prior to this release, the CSDE and AIR will be hosting a webinar that will introduce and train on the new features and provide tips for navigating the improved system. Individual Student Reports for Smarter Balanced, Science, and Skills Checklist Science

Paper copies of Individual Student Reports (ISRs) for Smarter Balanced English language arts/literacy and mathematics, the CMT/CAPT Science, and the Skills Checklist Science should have arrived in districts by September 16, 2016. Two copies of each student's ISR were provided; one to send to parents/guardians and the other for the student's permanent record.
