Spring 2020 Testing Using the AIR Secure Browser and Test Delivery System In preparation for 2020 testing using the American Institutes for Research (AIR) Test Delivery System, note the following resource regarding the AIR Secure Browser. The AIR provides updates to the Secure Browser for each supported operating system. These Secure Browser updates are provided by AIR annually, or when deemed necessary if bugs in the Secure Browser are detected. The Operating System Support Plan for Test Delivery document describes AIR's plan for supporting operating systems during the upcoming test administration and beyond. It is strongly recommended that districts review this resource to manage operating system deployments based on the support timelines. This means that after January 18, 2020, the <u>public and secure</u> sites will be taken down and not accessible by any member of the public, including school district users. If districts have a need for this data, it is recommended the data be downloaded, as soon as possible, before the closing date.

Update on the Activation of the Alternate Assessment Indicator in TIDE for Students Taking the Alternate Assessments

The Alternate Assessment Indicator has not been activated in TIDE based on eligibility forms submitted through the Data Entry Interface (DEI) at this point. The CSDE expects to begin this activation after January 15, 2020, to capture all current submissions, including those eligible Grade 11 students and dually identified English learners with a significant cognitive disability.

However, District Administrators and Teachers Administering the Alternate Assessment (TEAs) may want to generate a report to confirm the submission of the Connecticut Alternate Assessment Eligibility Form(s). Students in PSIS who attend Out-of-State Facilities or In-State, Non-Approved Facilities

Connecticut public school districts are responsible to test students enrolled in the Public School Information System (PSIS) who are being educated in out-of-state facilities or in-state, non-approved schools. This document includes information on how to administer the Connecticut statewide assessments for Smarter Balanced for English language arts and mathematics (Grades 3-8), the Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS) (Grades 5, 8, and 11), and the Connecticut SAT School Day (Grade 11). This document also includes information for administering the Connecticut Alternate Assessments (CTAA) for English language arts and mathematics (Grades 3, 8, and 11).

Speech-To-Text Brochure

This brochure is intended to guide decisions about the need for speech-to-text for a select group of students who need to access this accommodation, including options and procedures, particularly if software is incompatible with the Secure Test Delivery Interface. The majority of items across all grades on the Smarter Balanced Assessments, with the exception of the Math Performance Task and very few items on the ELA, are multiple choice and technology enabled and <u>do not</u> require typed responses. No items on the NGSS require typed responses.

Customized Speech-to-Text Accommodation Request for Smarter Balanced Summative Assessments

For students requiring a Customized Speech-to-Text accommodation as described in Option 3 of the <u>Speech -to-Text</u> <u>Brochure</u>, District Administrators (DAs in TIDE) complete and fax this form to the Office of Student Assessment, along with Pages 1, 8, and 11 of the student's Individual Education Program (IEP) or the entire Section 504 Plan to 860-713-7033 by **January 24, 2020**. This form should only be submitted for students who require a customized process to access speech-to-text software with the provision of a scribe on the Smarter Balanced Summative Assessments.

Submission of the Connecticut Alternate Assessment Eligibility Form through the Data Entry Interface

The Data Entry Interface (DEI) is open for the submission of the Connecticut Alternate Assessment Eligibility Forms. Forms <u>should not</u> be submitted <u>unless</u> students are eligible and meet **all three** of the required criteria specified by the form. The DEI will not accept submissions for responses that <u>do not</u> meet eligibility criteria. Please encourage your Teachers Administering the Alternate (TEAs) to respond accurately when submitting information, otherwise, edits can <u>only</u> be made when the DA requests a test **reset** using the Appeals process in TIDE.

Given that an early submission of eligibility forms ensures that students will have access to the Alternate Assessment at the time of testing, please note the deadlines based upon the following testing windows:
