#### TEAM FUNDING ALLOCATIONS

On February 15, 2019 the Connecticut State Department of Education (CSDE), using the data in the Connecticut Educator Data System (EDS), calculated the total number of active beginning teachers participating in TEAM since September 1, 2018. We are currently in the process of determining the total allocation per local education agency (LEA). LEAs can anticipate receiving the funds via the state grant system by the end of March.
