

Title II, Part A Transferred Funds

School districts and private schools have the option to programmatically transfer some or all of their grant allocation received under Title II, Part A - *Supporting Effective Instruction* for activities under Title I, Part A - *Improving Basic Programs* or Title III - *Language Instruction for English Learners and Immigrant Students*. Funds may not be transferred from Title I, Part A - *Improving Basic Programs*. If your school district intends to transfer funds, please note the following:

Transferred Funds:

- Programmatic: Title II, Part A transferred funds take on the requirements of Title I, Part A or Title III.

- Fiscal:
 - Public transfer - On the “Title I Ranking Schools and Allocating Funds” page, public Title II transferred funds are added to the school district’s total Title I allocation before determining the amount of Title I funds to be distributed to the district’s schools.*

On the Title II public budget and budget narrative, transferred funds are identified and explained in the object code “914” line item.
 - Private transfer - Transferred funds are identified and explained on the Title II private budget and budget narrative in the object code “914” line item.

*Equitable services provided to private school students and teachers under Title I, Part A would be based on a district’s total Title I allocation prior to any Title II transfer.
