5. **EPCRA and CWA Coordination (DEEP and DPH):** Notification Protocols and Mapping Coordination: David Kallander and Diane Duva provided updates on coordination between agencies regarding reporting and notification of releases that could affect drinking water sources, in the context of changes in EPCRA and CWA revisions. Chair Goudreau asked for follow up confirmation from DPH about current notification processes involving water companies. Diane Duva shared the information for how to access the CT Open Data portal.
6. **New Online Training Available to Facilities on Chemical Management and Climate Resilience:** Diane Duva introduced Connie Mendolia, DEEP, who gave a presentation on online training now available to assist businesses with adapting to increasing intensity and frequency of flooding as well as rising sea levels.
