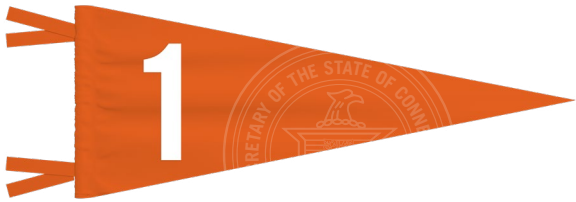


# IN COLLEGE AND WANT TO VOTE THIS YEAR BUT NOT SURE HOW?



If You Live On Campus, You Must  
Decide If You're Voting In Your:  
**HOMETOWN or COLLEGE TOWN**

(Can vote in either but not both)

**REGISTER**

(Whether voting in your HOMETOWN or at COLLEGE)



Decide If You're Voting **IN-PERSON**  
or by **ABSENTEE BALLOT**

(Polls open 6 am - 8 pm)

**LOOKUP Your Polling Place To Know Where To Go**

(Whether you're voting in-person in your  
HOMETOWN or at COLLEGE)



If You're **NOT** Voting **IN-PERSON** Check  
If You **CAN** Vote by **ABSENTEE BALLOT**

(Whether you're living in CT or at a school outside of CT)

**APPLY ONLINE or CONTACT YOUR CT TOWN CLERK**  
for an Absentee Ballot

# YOU CAN VOTE ABSENTEE

IF YOU'RE PREVENTED FROM VOTING IN-PERSON BECAUSE OF A **DISABILITY** OR **SICKNESS** OR BECAUSE YOU'LL BE **OUT OF TOWN** ON ELECTION DAY

## What do you need to do?

APPLY 1 OF 2 WAYS:

**IN-PERSON** with your Town Clerk or  
**ONLINE** with your CT Drivers License

Scan to APPLY ONLINE



**NEXT STEPS** (After applying online):



1. Wait for the ballot to come in the mail
2. Complete the ballot following the instructions
3. Mail the ballot in the provided envelope to your Town Clerk  
(You'll need to buy a postage stamp)

## 2023 ELECTION DATES

Primary Election: **SEPTEMBER 12**

(Check if your town has a primary)

General Election: **NOVEMBER 7**
