

NEED A LITTLE EXTRA HELP AT THE POLLS?

DO YOU KNOW ABOUT:

1 BALLOT MARKING DEVICE

If you can't read the ballot or can't fill it out, request an accessible voting machine to make your choices audibly or by touchscreen.

2 SOMEONE TO ASSIST

If you need someone to help read or mark the ballot: you can bring someone with you (except an agent of your employer or union, or a candidate on the ballot).

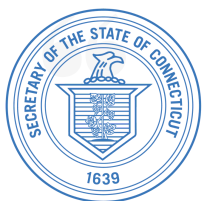
3 CURBSIDE VOTING

If you arrive at the polling place and cannot enter due to a temporary incapacity: you can ask to vote outside at the curb.

4 LINE PLACEHOLDER

If you can't stand in line for a long time: ask the Moderator that your place be held while you take a seat.

IF YOU'RE PREVENTED FROM VOTING IN-PERSON BECAUSE OF A **DISABILITY** OR **SICKNESS** OR BECAUSE YOU'LL BE **OUT OF TOWN** ON ELECTION DAY
