The table below provides key dates or deadlines for Early Voting before the September 9, 2025, Primary.

<b>Deadline for Town Clerk to Publish Notice of the Primary</b>	Forthwith after receiving notice from the Secretary of the State or registrars of voters, as applicable, that a primary will occur	Secretary of the State sends notice of primary to town clerks and sends list of offices: <b>August 6, 2025</b>  Deadline to notice primary: forthwith after receiving notice from the Secretary of the State that a primary will occur
<b>Deadline for Unaffiliated Voters to Enroll and Vote Early</b>	12:00 p.m. on the business day before the early voting period begins	Enrollment deadline: <b>August 29, 2025</b>
<b>Deadline for New Registrants to Register, Enroll, and Vote Early</b>	12:00 p.m. on the business day immediately before the day the individual wants to vote early	To vote starting on <b>September 2: Deadline is August 29, 2025, 12:00 p.m.</b>  To vote starting on <b>September 3: Deadline is September 2, 2025, 12:00 p.m.</b>  To vote starting on <b>September 4: Deadline is September 3, 2025, 12:00 p.m.</b>  To vote starting on <b>September 5: Deadline is September 4, 2025, 12:00 p.m.</b>  To vote starting on <b>September 6: Deadline is September 5, 2025, 12:00 p.m.</b>  To vote starting on <b>September 7: Deadline is September 5, 2025, 12:00 p.m.</b>
