TO REGISTRARS OF VOTERS:

We are pleased to send to you the prescribed form of the nonpartisan literature which you may distribute during the annual canvass of voters required by Section 9-32 of the General Statutes between January 1, 2021 and May 1, 2021.

Please note that we have enclosed <u>two versions</u> of the nonpartisan literature. One is the form for use in a <u>house-to-house</u> canvass (ED-320). The other form (ED-321) is for use in a <u>canvass by mail</u> to be included with the Notice of Canvass, which we are also sending to you.

The use of the nonpartisan literature is optional. Also optional, as indicated at the bottom of the enclosed forms, is the inclusion by you of information concerning voting districts and/or location of polling places. Although there is no specific statutory requirement (except for Bridgeport, East Hartford, Hartford, Meriden, New Britain, New Haven, New London, Waterbury and Windham, presently), we strongly recommend that municipalities which have 1% or more Hispanic population, but no less than 500 persons, who choose to use the optional nonpartisan literature, use the English and Spanish texts.
