HOW TO USE THIS BALLOT

CAUTION: This ballot may consist of more than one sheet.

I. TO MARK THIS BALLOT.

Completely fill in each appropriate oval as shown. Use a black or blue pen or marker. DO NOT USE PENCIL

Vote for candidates individually. Do not mark the party names in any way.

II. TO VOTE FOR CANDIDATES.

In most cases, only one mark or write-in vote is allowable in each column (that is, for each office).

A. TO VOTE FOR CANDIDATES ON THE BALLOT.

Completely fill in the oval above the name of each candidate for whom you wish to vote.

In the case of an office for which you may vote for two or more candidates, you may mark your ballot for the proper number of candidates anywhere in that group even though one may be directly below the other.

B. TO WRITE IN A VOTE for a registered write-in candidate for a particular office, use the write-in row spaces provided for this purpose. The space you use for writing in a person's name as a candidate must be directly below the column headed with the title of the office to which you wish this person elected. It will have the same number as shown in the column-heading for that office. See example in III below.

III. TO VOTE THE QUESTIONS.

Mark the YES or NO oval above your choice for each question on which you wish to vote.

I. PARA MARCAR SU VOTO:

Haga una marca bastante clara en el cuadro apropiado ovalado, según la ilustración que se ofrece a continuación: Use un bolígrafo o marcador negro o azul. NO USE LAPIZ Voto por los candidatos Individualmente. No marque el nombre de los partidos en ninguna forma.

II. PARA VOTAR POR CANDIDATOS.

En la mayoría de los casos, solamente se permite una marca o Voto por escrito en cada columna (es decir, para cada cargo oficial).

A. PARA VOTAR POR CANDIDATOS CUYOS NOMBRES APARECEN IMPRESOS EN LA PAPELETA. Marque el cuadro que aparece bajo el nombre de cada candidato por el cual usted desea votar.

B. PARA ESCRIBIR SU VOTO por un candidato que se ha registrado como un candidato por escrito para un cargo en particular, use la fila de espacios en blanco que ha sido dedicada para este propósito (encima de la fila Hamada "Voto en las Preguntas"). El espacio que usted use para escribir el nombre de una persona como candidato debe ser el que se encuentra directamente sobre la columna encabezada con el título del cargo oficial para el cual usted desea elegir dicha persona. Ese espacio tendrá el mismo número que aparece en el encabezamiento de la columna para ese cargo oficial. Véa el ejemplo bajo la Sección III a continuación.
