MERRILL: REGISTRATION DEADLINES TO VOTE IN MAY MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS APPROACHING

SECRETARY OF THE STATE REMINDS VOTERS THAT DEADLINE TO REGISTER TO VOTE IN MAY 6TH MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS APRIL 22ND BY MAIL, APRIL 29TH AT 8:00 P.M. IN-PERSON AT TOWN OFFICES

HARTFORD: Secretary of the State Denise Merrill today reminded eligible voters in 13 Connecticut communities that deadlines to register to vote in municipal elections on May 6, 2013 are approaching. The deadline to register to vote by mail is Monday April 22nd and the in-person voter registration deadline for the May election towns and boroughs is Monday April 29th at the town Registrar of Voters office.

"For the handful of Connecticut towns and boroughs holding their municipal elections on Monday May 6th there are voter registration deadlines approaching in the next couple of weeks," said Secretary Merrill, Connecticut's chief elections official. "Eligible voters in these communities have until Monday April 22nd to mail in their voter registration cards, and those wanting to register to vote in-person must do so by Monday April 29th at 8:00 p.m. at their Registrar of Voters office. Important decisions are being made in towns across the state of Connecticut, and by registering to vote town residents can have a say in who leads their community."

Polls will open from 6:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. for Municipal elections on Monday May 6, 2013 in the following communities: The towns of Andover, Bethany, Union and Woodbridge, and the Boroughs of Litchfield, Newtown, Stonington, Bantam(Litchfield), Danielson(Killingly), Fenwick (Old Saybrook), Jewett City (Griswold), Woodmont (Milford) and the City of Groton. The majority of Connecticut's municipalities will hold primaries if necessary on September 10, 2013 and a General Election for municipal candidates on November 5, 2013.
